**Educational Objective:** Prepare new leaders and professionals in Euro-Mediterranean issues

**Type & Duration of Master's Programme:** Full-time: August 2008 – October 2009

**Courses Offered:** 10 introductory courses in the General Track and 24 regular courses grouped into 3 Specific Tracks

**Internship:** Students can apply for an internship for a period of at least three months

**Languages of Instructions:** English and French

**Locations:** During the Programme students will study in different locations: Bibbiena and Terni (Tuscany & Umbria, Italy) and Cairo (Egypt) as well as Granada (Andalusia, Spain) or Ankara (Turkey)

**Credits:** 72 ECTS

**Entry Requirements:** Bachelor-level degree (minimum 3 years). Good working knowledge of English and French (candidates must be able to understand, speak and write in one of these two languages and at least understand the other one).

**Diploma:** The diploma-issuing Universities for the Second Session 2008/9 will be: University of Granada (Spain); University Pompeu Fabra (Spain); University of Firenze (Italy); University of Pisa (Italy)

**Grants:** Partial tuition waivers may be made available to students

The Second Session of the MAEM/MEMA is scheduled to start on 11 August 2008  
Enrolment for the Second Session starts on 30 November 2007 and ends on 18 April 2008
